### **Park discussion**

Quorum established. Reviewed online survey asking for PPNA member feedback – 24 total respondents. In summary, pros and cons were identified for each potential site, although priority would be for an area with PPNA boundaries and more in the middle section. Full results can be viewed here:

The group agreed that there are still many things to consider and we need to spend more time information seeking, but as a Board we would like to send a letter to the city advocating that they maintain ownership of the lot on Pierce Park (the one previously designated for the fire station) for some type of neighborhood city amenity.

### **Bylaws and officer roles**

Clarification still needed from the city on what signatures are needed for the by laws and the articles.

Crissy prepared a document to submit to ACHD that included the feedback from the Board with a recommendation for the misplaced left turn intersection design, a two-way bike lane on Gary Ln., the multi-use pathways on both sides of Glenwood, and the pedestrian/bike overpasses at both State and Glenwood.

Discussion about National Night Out (NNO). Roy Napper, previous PPNA president, shared information on previous events and his experience with this the last three years. The Board would like to find a volunteer to help coordinate. Terril has someone in mind and it was also suggested to reach out to student's who need summer projects at local high schools or universities. Liability coverage is not needed for Pierce Park Elementary and Crissy is working on getting a permit through the school district. We need to submit an application for our NNO event and the city will help coordinate city officials to visit the event. We agreed to do an informal dinner of hot dogs, sides, cookies, and water. This will take place on 8/7 from 6:00-8:30pm.
