I am writing this letter to follow-up on the January 9th meeting regarding Pierce Park Neighborhood Association interest in submitting a Neighborhood Investment program funding request for a multi-use pathway between the east end Baron Street and the newly constructed Hammermill Lane. ACHD is still reviewing the proposal to determine if and at what level we can participate.

The proposal does not contain enough information for ACHD to formally approve modifications to ACHD right-of-way or infrastructure or pursue involvement without further consultation. In general, ACHD is supportive of neighborhood efforts to enhance aesthetics and neighborhood identity and improved connectivity.

Prior to finalizing any designs and procuring materials the applicants for these projects must work with ACHD to ensure that the proposals meet our standards. ACHD will require license agreements for any improvements made within the public right-of-way. If the grants are awarded please direct the applicants to contact ACHD to work through the necessary details and permits.

Thank you – we appreciate the opportunity to comment early on these applications and look forward to working with the neighborhoods if the grants are approved.
